Today we start-out on **Amtrak** for a two hour ride to Jefferson City, where the motorcoach will be waiting for our arrival. Our first stop on today's tour is for lunch at **Prison Brew**, a unique pub located just two blocks from the old Missouri State Penitentiary. Lunch today consists of your choice between a few different items and sampling of beers. After our meal we head for a guided tour of **The Supreme Court Building** which was built with money that the state earned from the 1904 Worlds Fair. Afterwards, we'll be in for a real treat when we head for a 90 minute tour of the **Missouri State Penitentiary**, which held as many as 5300 inmates and was open from 1836 to 2004. We'll find out why Time Magazine has been quoted as saying "This was the bloodiest 47 acres in America", along with the many stories of famous convicts that called this place home, including James Earl Ray who escaped from the prison before killing Martin Luther King in 1968. This is going to be a fascinating, once in a lifetime tour but you must be able to stand and walk for approximately 90 minutes for the tour. Before departing for home, by motorcoach, we will stop at **Central Dairy** for an ice cream cone treat.

I am doing two trips to Jefferson City by Amtrak. If you cannot do a lot of walking, please sign up for the May 13th trip. Full payment is due by March 1.

19. BLACK HILLS OF SOUTH DAKOTA

May 23-29 • Cost Per Person \$825 Double; \$1,115 Single



We are heading to The Black Hills of South Dakota for many sights, shows and lots of fun.

DAY ONE - Sunday, May 23

Today we set off for the legendary Black Hills of South Dakota. We will stop **overnight in Sioux City, IA.** at a AAA rated hotel. Tonight's **dinner** will be included at a local restaurant.

DAY TWO - Monday, May 24

We will have a **continental breakfast** at the hotel before continuing on our journey. Today, we'll meet our **step-on guide** who will give us the history of **Badlands National Park**. As we travel on the Badlands Loop Hwy,

we'll see awesome views of nature in this 244,000 acre park. This park has been the site of many movies – from westerns to more modern-day flicks, such as "Thunder Heart". Before departing the area we will visit the internationally known **Wall Drug Store**. On a summer day this store brings in 20,000 visitors. We'll check into our AAA rated hotel in **Rapid City, SD** for a four night stay. **Dinner** will be included at a local restaurant.

DAY THREE - Tuesday, May 25

We'll start our day with a **continental breakfast** at the hotel. Afterwards, we'll meet our **step-on guide**, who is with us for the day, to give us the history of the sights. Today, we'll enjoy the **1880 Train Ride** through the beautiful Black Hills. Then, we'll visit the **Rushmore Borglum Historical Center** in Keystone, SD to learn why a man at 60 years of age would begin to carve a mountain. Next, we'll visit **Mt. Rushmore National Memorial Park** and then take a drive along the **Wildlife Loop** in **Custer State Park**, where the rolling prairies and pine covered hills offer one of the best spots in this region to view native animals in the wild. This evening we have a **western dinner with entertainment**.

DAY FOUR - Wednesday, May 26

We'll start our day with a **continental breakfast** at the hotel. Afterwards, we'll meet our **step-on guide**, who is with us for the day, to give the history of today's sights.
